Welcome, and thank you for coming out today to play with your dog and to enjoy the day with your agility friends.

We are looking forward to a great weekend of runs. Thank you to Haute Dawgs for asking us to join you once again.

A few reminders:

- Dogs run without collars
- No food, toys or other training devices allowed within 10 feet of the ring.
- Time starts when the dog crosses the plane of the first obstacle and ends when they take the last obstacle in the correct direction. Failure to finish the last obstacle will result in an NT.
- The club is permitting declared training in the ring at this trial. If you plan to use a toy, remember to show it to me before you run as I need to be sure that it is a permissible toy.
- Be ready to enter the ring when it is your turn. Check the course map to see when I have indicated for you to be in the ring ready to go.
- If at any time during your run you hear me say "thank you", that means your run is over.
- Keep your dog leashed at all times except in any designated off-leash areas. Be aware of your and other dogs to prevent any problems.
- If there is any question about a call or score, please first see the score keeper and check your scribe sheet. The score keeper will ask me to clarify the information.
