This event is designed to prepare both handler and dog for actual trialing. If you have been through agility classes, but are not quite ready to trial, this is an excellent chance for you to prepare for competition. **We ask that you have at least six full months of weekly training classes and that you participate with the concurrence of your instructor.** Runs will be timed, but no awards or placements will be given. This is not for competition, but for fun, experience, and practice. Treats and toys in the ring are encouraged, and praising your dog is mandatory. Jump height at your discretion (suggestion - jump at the match at the height you jump in class).

Saturday, a Jumpers and Standard course will run simultaneously inside. Sunday, a Regular course will be run inside followed by a Jumpers course and then a Tunnelers course to finish the day.

You should only put your dog on equipment that they have experience with. Avoid an obstacle that still requires more training to be safe on. Harsh corrections, either physical or verbal, will not be tolerated. Dogs cannot run on leash, and only flat buckle collars (with no tags/tabs) are allowed in the ring.

The organizing committee may refuse any entry for any reason. There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from the event, regardless of the reason for dismissal. It is expressly understood that entrants alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children, or guests. Any entrant whose dogs, children, or guests create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the organizing committee, be asked to remove the offending dogs, children, or guests from the event grounds. No refund of fees will be made in such a case. The Trial Chair, a Haute Dawgs Board member and/or gate steward may excuse team for any infractions with NO REFUNDS.

This match will be limited to 360 runs. We will allow day of match entries only until that total is reached.

DIRECTIONS TO WAG K9 FACILITY at 10925 Bruceville Road in Elk Grove:

From Hwy 5 to Elk Grove.

Take the Elk Grove Blvd exit and go East. Turn right on Bruceville Rd. Go approximately 3.5 miles to the driveway on the left. 10925 Bruceville Rd. Follow driveway to the rear. There will be a WAG K9 Facility sign on the fence.

From Hwy 99 to Elk Grove.

Take the Elk Grove Blvd exit and go West. Turn left on Bruceville Rd. Go approximately 3.5 miles to the driveway on the left. 10925 Bruceville Rd, follow driveway to rear. There will be a WAG K9 Facility sign on the fence.

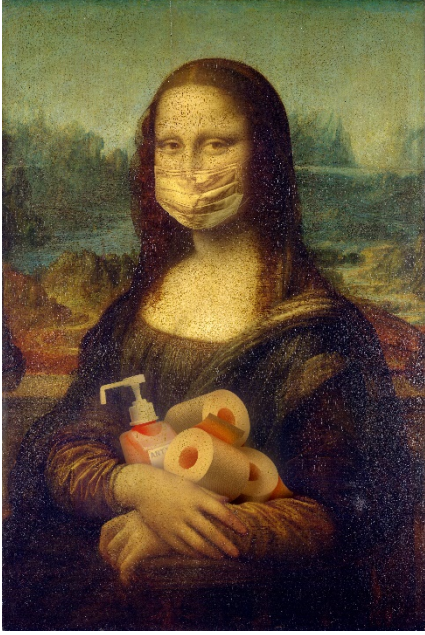
DUE to COVID-19 :

NO Water will be available on site. No snacks or lunches will be available for purchase on site. Please plan accordingly.

What to expect during COVID winter shows at WAG...



Now that we are nearing the winter season, we are evaluating the current protocols for COVID and how we can continue to manage our events with safety in mind for all.

Show sizes will stay at one ring size in the covered arena only to cut down on large crowds. However, since we will not be able to spread out as far as we have been during the summer/fall shows we need to look at the options we will have for social distancing. With people wanting to be in the arena more to avoid inclement weather and of course to watch and participate in the events, it's inevitable that our social distancing that has worked well while we were spread out all over the facility earlier in the year will be much more challenging.

Masks will be the necessary normal in the arena. Although our arena is very open air and that helps tremendously with ventilation, it will still be difficult

to avoid people passing through the aisles or sitting in front of their setups with adequate social distance to be consistently as safe as we'd like things to be. With that said, we still wish to implement social distancing as much as possible and request that whenever possible you keep your 6+ foot distance, even when wearing a mask. Congestion in some areas will be likely on occasion, but we can all work hard to keep these issues to a minimum by being mindful.

So, these are some of the things we are asking for everyone to help with:

- Wear your mask in the arena.
- If you are just taking a quick drink – no worries. However, eating your lunch, snacks – it would be best to take it outside, if the weather is decent or to your vehicle. If you crate with others in a stall, you could take turns being in the stall and away from the aisles to eat lunch. Those that crate on the south side of the arena – please note we will still need to keep the space utilized as efficient as possible.
- Visiting with friends – at 6+ feet – great! If you can't maintain that – and weather is decent – please take it outside.
- Crating – if you are comfortable crating from your trailer/camper or vehicle that would be very helpful to keep the numbers down in the arena. We will do our best to clear up more space as well for crating. We will also allow canopies to be setup in the front circle and the main lawn as well as in the RV row where there are open spaces. So, lots of room to spread out. Not always as convenient, but helpful overall for space. Remember, social distance is still what we are aiming to achieve for everyone when possible.
- Utilize the websites with show details more. We have had a lot of folks not ever looking at the run orders online and just going often to the gate to check on the run order. This does not help us cut down on interactions.

Lastly, be kind, courteous and helpful. We are all dealing with these tough circumstances as a community together. We don't need "mask police" tattling on every infraction. Just everyone trying to do their best for the sake of everyone else as well as for themselves. We want to be able to continue to offer our dog events for all to enjoy, but we do need cooperation from everyone to succeed in the best possible manner.

The undersigned is aware of the inherent risks of injury, death, and property damage to the undersigned, to his or her dog(s) that are involved in the recreational activity of canine agility, including without limitations, risks due to dog bite, the use of agility equipment, or infectious disease. The undersigned is aware of the risks of injury, death, and property damage that may result from, among other causes, the active or passive negligence of Haute Dawgs Agility Group, its Board, Officers, club members and WAG, Inc. The undersigned is voluntarily engaging in dog agility as a recreational activity with the knowledge of the risks of injury, death, and property damage that may result from participation on dog agility.

2. Release of Liability

The undersigned releases Haute Dawgs Agility Group, its Board, Officers, club members and WAG, Inc, from all liability to the undersigned, the "undersigned" representatives, guardians, successors, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for all liability, claims, damage, or demands for personal injury, death, or property damage, to the undersigned or the undersigned's dog or dogs, arising from or related to this agreement. This release includes, without limitation, any personal injury, death, or property damage caused by the active or passive negligence of Haute Dawgs Agility Group, its Board, Officers, club members or WAG, Inc. The undersigned bears sole responsibility for any loss.

3. Knowing and Voluntary Execution

The undersigned acknowledges that he or she has carefully read this agreement, understands its contents, and understands that this agreement includes an assumption of risk of the Haute Dawgs Agility Group, its Board, Officers, club members and WAG Inc.'s negligence and a release of their liability. The undersigned acknowledges that Haute Dawgs Agility Group, its Board, Officers, club members and WAG, Inc. are materially relying on this waiver in allowing the undersigned to participate in this dog agility event.

4. I also state my dog(s) is/are not aggressive towards people or other dogs and that I understand I alone am responsible for the behavior of my dog(s), that any dog, which is out of control, creates an unnecessary disturbance or engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the organizing committee, be expelled from the event grounds with NO REFUNDS.
