### JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

## Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com) for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.

- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but it cannot be used during your run, nor can you indicate to the dog it is there. Only Intro and Novice handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

## AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), **Haute Dawgs Agility Group** (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), **WAG, Inc.** (including its officers, agents, and employees), and Ironwood and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons



### WAG FACILITY RULES

All exhibitors are subject to ejection for failure to comply

1. Respect all the grounds - pick up after your dog at all times- everywhere on the property. Please pick up all your trash and dispose of properly. Do not allow your dogs to urinate anywhere on the buildings, garbage cans, or planters.
2. Obey all speed and parking signs. Driveway speed is 5MPH and will be enforced.
3. Be aware of your dog and your immediate surroundings. Dog aggression will not be tolerated. No dog may be left tied up unattended - at any time.
4. Respect the agility equipment and all of the facility buildings. Do not use equipment not in use by club.
5. If there are problems/issues with the facility, please inform a club member and/or the facility owners.
6. All children must be supervised at all times.

## Haute Dawgs Agility Group COVID-19 GUIDELINES

Haute Dawgs Agility Group is committed to following the guidelines suggested by our county to help protect our exhibitors, crew and judges from the spread of COVID-19. That primarily means we will employ social distancing as much as possible, and wear masks when that is not possible. We know that means creating some new habits for most of us, so we will all be patient with each other and issue gentle reminders if necessary. Many in our agility community are in categories considered at higher risk in this pandemic, so please be respectful of others by following these measures so we can all get back to the sport we love. We will of course continue to monitor the guidance as it evolves and adjust our measures, as necessary.

**Masks** - Masks should be worn when you are not able to maintain the 6-foot distancing, such as:

- When exiting and entering an area or walking in areas where social distancing might not be possible.
- When walking a course since it will be difficult to maintain 6-foot distancing.
- When you want to have a close one-on-one conversation with others outside your household.
- You will not be required to wear a mask when running a course.
- Since you may end up taking your mask on and off many times during the day, please keep your mask handy at all times. Should you forget your mask, we will have disposable ones available for purchase.

**Social distancing** - Please maintain a 6-foot distance from others to the greatest extent possible. This applies to dogs also – please keep your dog at your side and don't allow them to interact with other dogs or other people.

**Crating space** –If you are comfortable crating from your trailer/camper or vehicle that would be very helpful to keep the numbers down in the arena. We will do our best to clear up more space as well for crating. We will also allow canopies to be setup in the front circle and the main lawn as well as in the RV row were there are open spaces.

**Walk thrus and waiting to run** – Walk thrus will be monitored to avoid congestion and may be staggered if the class size is too big. Masks will be required while walking a course, unless you are the only person out walking.

**Volunteers** – Workers will maintain social distance at all times. Scribe and timer will have 6 feet space between them at the scribe table. Leash runner will be given a leash grabber to move the leash for those folks that choose not to carry their leash in their pocket. NADAC is allowing you to carry your leash with you if you can fully fit it in a pocket or a small fanny pack where it cannot be seen by the dog or fall out or be loose while running.

**Scores & Course Maps** – The plan is to have scores posted online (details will be included in the show notes). Course maps, Morning Briefing, and other information will be emailed to exhibitors and/or posted online for exhibitors to access electronically.

**Course Builders and Pole setters** – CDC guidance is now indicating that contracting the virus from touching surfaces is less likely than initially feared, so we will allow folks to help set bars and move equipment. Please remain vigilant and try to wash hands or use sanitizer before touching your face.

**Hospitality** – Our normal hospitality will NOT be hosted during COVID. We are sorry for the inconvenience of not being able to offer food and drinks. Please plan on bringing along everything you will need for you and your dog including food and drinks.

**Hand sanitizer & Hand washing** – We will have hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes available around the area. Please wash your hands frequently.
