

How to Get the Most out of MyDogEntry at our Haute Dawgs CPE Trial

We use MyDogEntry at our CPE trials for Check-In, Real-Time Run Orders, Maps and Results. MyDogEntry is a website, not an app, so you won't find it in the App Store and you won't find it in Google Play. Just open an Internet browser and type in mydogentry.com. If your phone offers to "install" MyDogEntry, please agree. Installing MyDogEntry creates an icon on your home screen and makes it easier to launch.

Online check-in will be available using MyDogEntry starting at 1:00 AM each day. There will be a large "Check-In" button at the top of the MyDogEntry screen. Online check-in is easier if you login to your MyDogEntry account:

- If you **are** logged in to your MyDogEntry account, then you'll see a list of **your** dogs when you click the "Check-In" button. For each of your dogs click "Check-In" or "Scratch" for each class.
- If you are **not** logged in to your MyDogEntry account, then you'll see a list of **all** dogs when you click the "Check-In" button. Scroll down to find your dog's name. Click on your dog and then click "Check-In" or "Scratch" for each class.

This can be done using your home computer, a tablet, or a mobile phone.

Real-Time Run Order will also be available. Look for the large "Run Order" button at the top of the MyDogEntry screen. The button will be available closer to the trial. There will be an estimated run time for each dog. Estimated run times update automatically throughout the day. These times are only estimates. Dogs may run earlier or later. Your dog will be highlighted in green if you are logged in to your MyDogEntry account.

Maps will be available as well. Look for the "Maps" button next to the "Run Order" button.

Once **results** are entered into the scoring system, a large "Results" button will be available at the top of the MyDogEntry screen. You will be able to see your dog's preliminary results for each class if you are logged into your MyDogEntry account. These results are **not** official and there will be no placement information.

If you know your MyDogEntry password, just [login](#).

If not, then check your confirmation email for information about setting your password.

It will be helpful to know your MyDogEntry password and save it on your phone if possible.
